

## HOW TO USE THE HOT TUBS

Please note that if you have not booked a hot-tub with us and paid the £50 surcharge in advance, the tub will not be filled or prepared. If you decide that you would like to use the tub, please let us know and we shall fill and prepare it for you. Under no circumstances should you try to fill the tub on your own without communicating with us first.

On some of the tubs there is a lever just underneath the log burner. It says 'OPEN/CLOSE'. This lever opens the plug, to drain the water from the tub. DO NOT OPEN IT. If the water drains from the tub whilst the fire is going, then it will be damaged. It also takes nearly 2 hours to fill back up from the hose.

### **SAFETY:**

Using the tub can result in drowning or burns. You use the tub entirely at your own risk. Never leave children unattended around the tub, and check the water temperature before getting in.

### **HOW TO USE YOUR TUB:**

1. Lift the lid, and ensure that it is full of water to ABOVE the upper water inlet/outlet hole. Re-close the lid.
2. Light the fire. Kiln dried logs, firelighters and matches are provided. If you require more, then go to the log store near the car park. To adjust airflow/draw you can open/close the ash tray as desired. Note that the lever beneath the stove empties the water, it does NOT adjust air flow.
3. For the first 1-2 hours add a log/attend to the fire every 15-20 minutes; this will bring the temperature level up quickly. It also helps to switch the bubbles on or use the paddle to circulate the water.
4. Once the tub has reached or is nearing the desired temperature, just add a log as required to keep the fire going whilst you're using the tub or have the lid open.
5. We recommend showering before using the tub; dirt and products can make the water scummy, which isn't nice if you plan to use the tub over consecutive days.
6. The lid is insulated. If you keep the lid closed whilst not in use, then the water will stay warm, and re-heat quickly on consecutive days.
